CAC Produces Input for Industry and City on Communications about Plant Events

The Citizen's Advisory Council (CAC) to La Porte Industry recently brought together nearly 60 CAC community members, plant representatives, and visitors to critique actual messages posted in recent months on CAER Online or on the City of La Porte website and social media to alert residents and businesses to plant events that might concern them, such as fires, odors, and smoke at or near industrial operations.

Attendees talked with each other about messages that worked and those needing clarity or details. Their input is being compiled and will be provided to both industry and the city to help improve their communications with the community about plant events. A variety of communications could be needed, ranging from a courtesy message just providing information to a warning from the city to shelter in place.

To sign up for such message from cities where you live or work, search for "City of ____, Texas" and look for "Sign Up for Notifications" or similar words.

To locate industry messages about plant events, download the CAER Online app from the App Store or Google Play or look for CAER at www.ehcma.org. CAER stands for Community Awareness and Emergency Response.
