



CITIZEN'S ADVISORY COUNCIL TO LA PORTE INDUSTRY

SH-225 and I-610 PEL Study

In a follow-up to the April meeting about local roadways, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) provided an update on the SH 225 and I-610 East Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) Study. Roger Gonzalez, Project Manager, Entech Civil Engineers spoke on the progress of the SH 225 and I-610 East PEL Study. A PEL study is a high-level early-stage planning study that considers environmental, community, and economic conditions while identifying transportation needs and providing recommendations. The study has defined the conceptual alternatives and needs to be considered. Rogers explained the seven primary alternatives and how they meet the needs of the study. Attendees participated in a poll at the meeting. Information was presented on how to stay engaged with the progress of the PEL study. A public meeting will be held in October 2023.
